Personal sail numbers may be issued by the national authority in a sailor's home country. Personal sail numbers are additional to the sail numbers issued to all boats. If the use of a personal sail number is likely to cause confusion, a race committee may require that a boat use the sail number issued under rule 15.4, or another agreed number

Proposed: DEN and SWE

Reasoning: a few sailors like to retain a specific sail number which can be transferred to newer boats. Currently the use of Personal Sail Numbers (PSN) is not allowed in class rules
